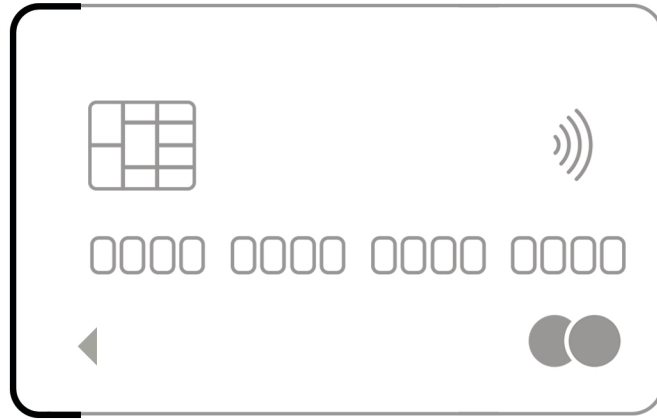

HOW TO MEASURE A RING YOU'RE WEARING

1. Print the gauge by selecting "Print Full Size" (be sure not to select "Scale to Sheet").
To make sure that the printout is scaled correctly, the width of your credit card should fit within the scaling line :

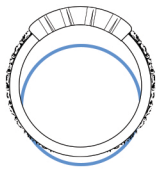


2. Take a ring with regular edges that you already own and wear on the ring you plan to wear your new Dior ring.

3. Place the ring on the circles of the gauge until it fits perfectly over one of the blue circles.
The number on this circle is your ring size.

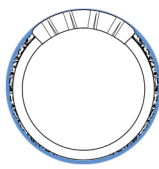
If you are not sure which size to choose, we recommend you choose the larger size.
For an open ring, we advise you to pick one size smaller.

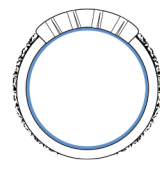

Your ring does not line up with the blue circle.



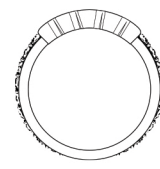

The blue circle is covered by your ring.



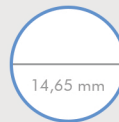
